Review of ENA ER P28 — Invitation to Participate

Dear industry stakeholder

The Energy Networks Association (ENA) is responsible for maintenance of Engineering Recommendation (ER) P28, *Planning Limits for Voltage Fluctuations Caused by Industrial, Commercial and Domestic Equipment in the United Kingdom*. ER P28 is referenced in the Grid Code and forms part of the Distribution Code, being listed as an Annex 1 Standard. ER P28 Issue 1 was last published in 1989 and is proposed for review.

The Grid Code Review Panel (GCRP) and the Distribution Code Review Panel (DCRP) of Great Britain (GB) wish to consult with various key stakeholders and third parties that could be materially affected by the review of ER P28. As such, the GCRP and DCRP have sanctioned ENA to establish a joint Working Group to review ER P28.

Nominations for membership of the Working Group are currently being sought. If you or another suitable person in your organisation would like to participate in the Working Group, you are kindly requested to register your interest. Where your organisation is a member of a manufacturer trade association, you are requested to register your interest through that trade association.


The deadline to register your interest is Friday, 3rd October 2014. All registrations of interest should state the following.
