

# G100 Review Working Group

## 1. Introduction

At a recent ENA EU Network Codes Steering Group (NC SG) a review of the current G100 document was initiated. The work should also recognize the parallel DCRP work on clarifying the treatment of storage in Distribution Code documents.

## 2. <u>Responsibilities</u>

The responsibilities of this working group will include:

- To provide a forum for Distribution Network Operators (DNOs) to review and consider the current applications of G100
- Understand and decide on a direction for the continued use of G100, either in a revised state or incorporated as part of other documentation.

## 3. <u>Scope</u>

The G100 Review Working Group will;

- Meet at a frequency determined by the Working Group.
- consider the issues raised in the NC SG meeting and how to address them.
- In doing so it shall;
  - i. Review the document and its place within the current ENA document framework.
  - ii. Consider if the document is still needed in any form.
  - iii. If the content is still needed, consider the likely details of a future modification
- iv. Consider if there are other routes to achieving the same ends, such as including the relevant content in other ENA or industry documents.
- v. Review the operation of the G99 Fast Track scheme and its interaction/reliance on G100

### 4. <u>Reporting</u>

The Work Group will report its findings to the European Union Network Codes (EU NC) Working Group.

### 5. Membership and Logistics

The group membership will consist of DNO members. Depending on the recommendations arising from the scope above it might be appropriate to include other stakeholders. The first Work Group meeting was held on 14 July 2020, and with meetings planned on a monthly basis thereafter.

• The Technical Secretariat for the Work Group will be provided by the ENA.
