## **1 Governance**

## **3 Administration**

The frequency of WG meetings will be determined as necessary by the WG.

The ENA will provide the technical secretariat and project management.

The WG will be able to make use of consultant or other resources provided by the network licensees for these purposes.

## **4 Scope**

1. The scope of the work is in two parts or phases. These terms of reference concentrate on phase 1.
2. In scope for phase 1:
  - 2.1. Review the perceived deficiencies of the current arrangements
  - 2.2. Consider what is required of a future security standard
  - 2.3. Evaluate potential options achieving desired security arrangements
  - 2.4. Evaluate implications of the options
  - 2.5. Recognize the impact of changes in technology
  - 2.6. Recognize the impact of changes in customer behaviour
  - 2.7. Recognize the impact of smart grids
  - 2.8. Recognize the impact of EU Network codes
3. The WG may, in consultation with the DCRP, publicly consult on its approach and findings.
4. It is envisaged that there will be a full public consultation on the outcome of phase 1 which the WG will need to administer.
5. Phase 2 will be the implementation of changes, based on the work of phase 1

## **5 Deliverables**

1. The primary output of phase 1 will be a report recommending to what extent and how security requirements should be specified in future.
2. The report should include:
  - 2.1. Clear description of what security is appropriate in the future
  - 2.2. How this is defined
  - 2.3. How this is to be achieved
  - 2.4. Implications for network Users and stakeholders
  - 2.5. Implications for core industry documents
  - 2.6. Suggested approach to Phase 2

## **6 Timescales**

It is expected that the phase 1 report of the WG will be available in the Summer of 2014.
